Condition of Entry



All Staff/Exhibitors/Attendees of the Expo will be required to register for the event before being granted access to the venue. Entry is free and visitors are encouraged to pre-register online via the website prior to coming to the venue. A unique QR code will be generated once registration has been complete. This QR code can be scanned upon entrance to the venue on the day of the event.

COVID Safe Measures

You will be unable to enter the Expo if you have symptoms conducive with COVID-19 (e.g. fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat or headache). If you have or believe you may have COVID-19 you must not enter the venue.

Hand sanitisation stations and hand washing stations will be available throughout the event and will be easily identifiable by signage. Patrons are encouraged to regularly wash and/or sanitise their hands during their visit to the Expo.

One-way aisle directional flow will be in place together with a single entry and exit point.

Regular Expo announcements will be conducted over the PA system to remind all attendees at the event to ensure hygiene considerations are observed and one way aisle traffic flows are maintained.
